

# **AeQuilibrium Beach Volley Marathon®**

## **- General Rules 2024 -**

Those participating must understand and accept the following rules

### **Main Rules of the Tournament**

- The team formation is determined at the moment of the registration, when entering the names of the Athletes; every variation (for example: Athletes substitution and/or new entry, variations of previously entered data, medical certificate upload) can be done also after the registration via email – [bvm@radunisportivi.it](mailto:bvm@radunisportivi.it) – or with a formal request in Bibione at the moment of the check-in.
- Athletes who are part of a team cannot be part of another team in the same game category.
- The 2x2 categories may use a reserve to substitute a main player only at the beginning of a match, or if a player is injured, the reserve may substitute the player at any time during the match, but only once.
- The 3x3 and 4x4 categories may use two reserves per team. In this case, the substitutions can occur without a formal request to the referee, when the game has been stopped and for an unlimited number of times.
- If during the tournament the players in the court are not the same as the team formation, the Director of the Tournament will immediately expel the team from the tournament. without the awarding of any prize money. The expulsion of a team will not affect the sorting of teams for a second chance.
- If a final scoreboard (or a 3x3 or 4x4 category) has less than 32 teams registered, these teams will be entered in the preceding scoreboard. For example, the scoreboard "Bronze" counts 30 teams, which will be in scoreboard "Silver"; in this case, the prize money (in the example the scoreboard "Bronze" prize money) is cancelled and won't be cumulated with the prize money of other categories.
- Teams are not allowed to start or continue a match if they have fewer players than those set for their category. If there are no reserve players and the number of the athletes of a team is lower than the one set for the category, the match will be interrupted, and the opposing team wins the game. In this case, the opposing team gains the points needed to win the set; the incomplete team, instead, keeps the points gained at the time of the suspension.
- The court is changed after every seven points (or every five if the set is played to 15 points).
- Each team may ask for a 30 second time-out per game.
- Even though there are no fixed positions for the players on the court, or rotations (all players in every position of the court can block and/or attack), the service order must always be kept during each match. At the moment of the service, all players must be inside the court, except for the player serving.
- The player has eight seconds to serve after the referee blows the whistle; if the ball is served before the whistle the serve has to be repeated.
- If the ball, after being thrown up by the serving player, lands on the ground or on the serving player himself and he/she cannot hit the ball to send it to the opposite court, this is considered as an attempt to serve and, consequently, the action is lost. During the service, the ball can touch the net while crossing it. If, while serving, the ball touches the antenna it is considered "out".
- If two opponents touch the ball over the net at the same time ("Held ball"), and the ball is not clearly in one of the two sides of the court, the game can continue. However, if after the simultaneous touch the ball hits one of the antennae, the action has to be repeated.
- The ball can be touched with any part of the body. The ball has to cross the net within the team's three contacts.
- The player can touch the ball even over the net, when blocking, as long as he/she does not interfere with the opponents' moves before or during their offence. The blocking team will have only two more contacts after a blocking contact. Any player may touch the ball first after a block; this also includes the player that touched the ball to block it.

- The ball must be hit cleanly and not held. Exceptions may occur for defensive actions if the ball is going very fast and from a short distance. In this case the ball can be briefly held for a moment also with the hands.
- The served ball can be received with a set; in this case contact with the ball must be clean, like any other set (overhand pass or bump set).
- The ball thrown over to the opponents' side of the court must go over the net within the crossing space allowed. The crossing space is the part of the vertical plane of the net limited, below, by the top of the net and, at the sides, by the antennae and their projection.
- Players can enter the opponents' court and/or the free zone as long as this does not interfere with the opponents' play.
- The teammate(s) of the player who is serving must not obstruct the opponents' view of the server and the trajectory of the ball; if asked to move, they must do so.
- It is considered a fault when a player attacks using a set and the ball does not follow the flight path trajectory of the shoulder line, unless the ball is meant for a teammate and ends by mistake in the opponents' court.
- It is considered a fault when a player hits the ball slowly with an open hand (shot) to attack. However, you can poke the ball with your fingers (cobra) or poke the ball with your knuckles (camel toe). In any case, contact with the ball must be clean.
- Players must play barefoot or with technical footwear, unless otherwise authorised by the referee.
- If there is an external interference (e.g.: a ball on the court) the game will be interrupted, and the action repeated.
- In case of injury, in the absence of reserves, the injured player is given a medical injury time-out of 5 minutes from the arrival on the field of the medical staff. The Tournament Director, called to check the extent of the injury, may give the injured player an additional recovery time of 10 minutes, in the spirit of "fair play" that must be evident in each match.
- Each team needs its own Beach Volleyball ball.
- The event will take place in any weather condition. In case of particularly adverse weather conditions or circumstances (other external events) The Tournament Director may decide to suspend one or more matches and choose to resume them when external conditions allow. With the resumption of the match, the score set at the time of suspension will be maintained.
- The Tournament Director, at his absolute discretion, may decide the final suspension of the matches or to modify this regulation: for example he/she can decide to modify the playing formula by providing that matches shall be played at 15 points instead of 21 and/or by knockout during the qualifying phase and/or foreseeing a reduction in the number of matches in the group and/or anything else not stated above.
- For all that has not been explicitly stated here, the rules of the international Beach Volleyball game will be valid.

## **General information**

**AeQuilibrium Beach Volley Marathon®** is the most popular and most attended open event of this discipline, a celebration of sport and fun. Held in Bibione (Venice - Italy), the Tournament gathers every year tens of thousands Beach Volley amateurs of every age and every game level, from all over the world. Animation, entertainment, night parties on the beach and accommodation organised by us and henceforth referred to as affiliated complete the offer of an unique sport event.

The organisation of the **AeQuilibrium Beach Volley Marathon®** is by SportFelix®, the brand of the tour operator Raduni Sportivi Srl.

The organising office will offer an assistance service from registration to the end of the sports event, helping participants choose the most suitable programs and solutions.

- Subscribing to the event, Participants declare that they know and respect this Regulation of the event and the [General Conditions of Sale of package tours](#). In case of underaged Athletes, a

parent/guardian must consent to the participation of the minor to the event, respecting this Regulation and the "General conditions of sale of package tours".

- Participants (in case of underaged Athletes, their parents/guardians) release the Organizer, the Promoting bodies, the City Council, the Sponsors and the delegates of the aforementioned subjects, of any present and future claims or responsibilities arising from participation in the event.
- Participants (in case of underaged athletes, their parents/guardians), according to what was established by art. 97 of Copyright Law (L. 22nd April 1941, n. 633), accept that the Organization can take photos and record videos during the whole event and, therefore, distribute them. This material is going to be published in websites, social networks, magazines, TV, promotional flyers or inserted into any kind of document to be distributed by the Organization for any legitimate use without compensation.
- Personal data is going to be collected in paper form as well as by computerised and telematic tools and managed for purposes strictly related to the company. The data is going to be processed in accordance with the general principles established by art. 11 of the Personal Data Protection Code and arts. 5 & 6 of the General Data Protection Regulation, that is to say, according to correctness, accuracy, completeness and suitability according to the purposes of the organising society.
- Every modification to the playing formula possibly made during the event, even the eventual definitive suspension of the matches, will not imply any refund obligation by the Organisation.

### Where and when

Playing courts: on the beach in front of the Thermal Complex (access from via delle Colonie, 4 and from via Ariete).

- May 2024 - Match days: Friday 10th, Saturday 11th and Sunday 12th
- June 2024 (*Special Edition*) - Match days: Friday 7th, Saturday 8th and Sunday 9th
- September 2024 - Match days: Friday 20th, Saturday 21st and Sunday 22nd.

### Registration

You can register at the AeQuilibrium Beach Volley Marathon® as "Athlete", joining the tournament with a team, or as "Non-Athlete", in this case you can use reserved Beach Volleyball courts and, if desired, participate in the Beach Sitting ParaVolley, an open tournament in which athletes of different abilities compete against each other. For under age participants, it will be the parent/guardian who will consent to the participation of the under age in the sport event. All participants ("Athlete" and "Non-Athlete") can access for free the evening parties on the beach, there are discounts in pizzerias and [affiliated clubs](#), reduction on the cost of entry to the thermal pools and to the beach service. On the occasion of the sport event, the "White Night" will be promoted, which consists of entertainment events in the various clubs of the tourist location which for the occasion will have extended opening hours until late at night. For all participants ("Athletes" and "Non-Athletes"), whether or not they have booked the affiliated accommodation, the registration procedure from the link [REGISTER NOW](#) requires subsequent registration on the "Sportfelix" app, available for iOS in AppStore and for Android in PlayStore. Once registered, with the same credentials used to register on the site, a QR Code will appear in the "Ticket" section of the app which will allow the use of the various services offered. The registration procedure for "Non-Athletes" without affiliated accommodation can also be carried out using the "Sportfelix" app only, thus avoiding online booking from the website.

### QR Code

For all participants ("Athletes" and "Non-Athletes"), whether or not they have booked the affiliated accommodation, the registration procedure ([REGISTER NOW](#)) requires subsequent registration on the "Sportfelix" app, available for iOS in AppStore and for Android in PlayStore. Once registered, with the same credentials used to register on the site, a QR Code will appear in the "Ticket" section of the app which will allow the use of the various services offered. The registration procedure for "Non-Athletes" without affiliated accommodation can also be carried out using the "Sportfelix" app only, thus avoiding

online booking from the website.

### **Special Edition**

The 2024 edition offers, in addition to the well known editions of May and September, a *Special Edition* which will take place side by side with the Final Game of the Italian Beach Volley Society Championship, held in Bibione during the weekend 6th-7th-8th June. The *Special Edition* is an open Tournament aimed at the 2x2 Mixed game categories, 3x3 Female, 3x3 Male and 4x4 Mixed while, 2x2 Male and 2x2 Female game categories are reserved only to teams composed of foreign athletes.

### **Beach Sitting ParaVolley**

The AeQuilibrium Beach Volley Marathon® of May will host the only Italian stage of the International Beach ParaVolley Championship (Sitting and Standing) which will take place on Friday, Saturday and Sunday with limited availability. Anyone who has registered as "Non-Athlete" can participate for free with a team (3x3 Male and 3x3 Female game category) in this original open tournament without prize money and which explores new inclusion possibilities.

### **Tournament fees**

The tournament fee comprises the 'Athlete fee' and a 'Team fees'. The 'Athlete fee' can be paid at check-in or, at registration, together with the 'Team fee'. The 'Athlete fee' is personal and it is to be paid once only, for the same event, even if the athlete is registered in more than one team of a different category **NB:** for the *Special Edition* it is not required to pay the Athlete fee if the athlete has already participated in the May edition. The Tournament participation includes: a tank top for each registered athlete part of a team | Ambulance service and medical staff | Access to the Welcome Party (on Thursday night – only for the May edition) | Access to the night beach parties on Friday and Saturday | Discounted entrance ticket to the thermal water swimming pools complex | Discounts on renting beach umbrellas and beach loungers | Discounts in pizzerias and other affiliated restaurants/pubs/bars/shops. The Tournament participation does not include: Tourist tax (when making use of accommodation) | Personal extras and anything not mentioned.

### **Non-Athlete fee**

The 'Non-Athlete fee' is a personal fee intended for those who are not playing in the Tournament with their own team but wish to take part in the event. The 'Non-Athlete fee' includes: Access to dedicated Beach Volley courts | Participation, subject to availability, with a team to the Beach Sitting ParaVolley (3x3 Male and Female categories) | Ambulance service and medical staff | Access to the Welcome Party (on Thursday night – only for the May edition) | Access to the night beach parties on Friday and Saturday | Discounted entrance ticket to the thermal water swimming pools at the Bibione Thermae complex | Discounts on renting beach umbrellas and beach loungers | Discounts in pizzerias and other affiliated restaurants/pubs/bars/shops. The 'Non-Athlete fee' does not include: Tourist tax (when making use of accommodation) | Personal extras and anything not mentioned.

### **Insurance in case of withdrawal due to health issues or injuries**

During registration, participating athletes will be able to apply for an optional coverage (12.00 euros) covering the risk of non-participation in the sports event due to health issues or injuries. The refund can be requested to the organiser by e-mail (bvm@radunisportivi.it) up to 48 hours prior to the beginning of the sports event, attaching the medical files attesting the health condition or injury with the prognosis. The refund will be calculated on the payments made under the headings 'Team fee' and 'Accommodation' according to the following guidelines: the result of the ratio between the payment of the 'Team fee' and the number of the team members, will be added to the result of the ratio of the payment of the accommodation only (where the person requesting the refund would have stayed) and the number of beds of the self-same accommodation. The purchase of the policy has to be made at the same time of the registration. The 'Athlete fee', the 'Non-Athlete fee', all optional services and personal

extras and the transport cost will not be included in the refund. Refund requests which arrive later than 48 hours before the starting of the sports event will not be accepted. Likewise refund requests with a prognosis not covering the entire duration of the sports event will not be accepted. The refund will be granted for a maximum of one participant registered as 'Athlete' in one or more of the 2×2 M/F/Mixed and 3×3 M/F categories teams, and for a maximum of two participants registered as 'Athletes' in one or more 4×4 Mixed categories teams. **Note:** the refund will be made after the event has taken place. Any request to add new 'Athletes' made after the activation of the refund request is to be considered a replacement and will cancel the right to refund.

### Personal injuries insurance policy

Athletes without a personal insurance policy will be able to optionally add 12.00 euros to their registration fee. This will allow them to have coverage for injuries while participating in the sports activities of the event. The policy is personal and non-refundable. ### Health certificate

To participate in the tournament as 'Athlete' you must have a fitness medical certificate for non competitive sports (certificate of good health issued by your GP/family doctor) or, alternatively, a fitness medical certificate for competitive sports – which must be valid at the time of the dates of the event. At registration, all medical certificates of all team members must be uploaded online. An exception to the above will be made for all athletes, members of a recognized sports promotion body or of a national sports federation recognised by the CONI (the Italian Olympic Games Committee), who will have a fitness medical certificate for sports valid for the season. These athletes, at registration, will state the body/federation they are members of and declare that their fitness medical certificate for sports is valid at the time of the event. **Note:** during the event a doctor will be at the disposal of the participants who want to get their health certificate for sports. It will be possible to get a payable doctor's appointment (without booking) in the medical area near the central court as below scheduled: Thursday from 6:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. | Friday from 7:45 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. | Saturday from 7:45 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

### Looking for a team/athlete

If you're looking for a team to play in or you can't find a player to complete your team, you can post your request in the Facebook group "Cerco squadra e giocatore BeachVolleyMarathon" ("[Looking for a team and athlete BeachVolleyMarathon](#)").

### Download the app

### Who is the tournament for

The tournament is for teams at any expertise and age (participations to athletes younger than 15 is not recommended) and skill divided in the following categories.

#### 10th-11th-12th May and 20th -21st- 22nd September 2024 editions

Athletes cannot be registered in more than one team of the same category but they can be registered in other teams of different categories. Participation in the sport event entails the acceptance of the "General Rules".

Categories:

- 2×2 Female: 2 women in court + 1 possible reserve F / Match days: Friday and Saturday
- 2×2 Male: 2 men in court + 1 possible reserve M / Match days: Friday and Saturday
- 2×2 Mixed: 1 man and 1 woman in court + 1 possible reserve F or M / Match days: Friday afternoon and Sunday

- 3x3 Female: 3 women in court + 2 possible reserves F / Match days: Saturday and Sunday
- 3x3 Male: 3 men in court + 2 possible reserves M / Match days: Saturday and Sunday
- 4x4 Mixed: 2 men and 2 women in court + 2 possible reserves F and/or M / Match days: Saturday and Sunday

#### **Special Edition 07th -08th - 09th June 2024**

Team members can not play in other teams of the same category, but can play in one or more teams in different categories.

Categories:

- 2x2 Female (teams composed only of foreign athletes): 2 women in court+ 1 possible reserve F. / Match days: Friday and Saturday
  - 2x2 Male (teams composed only of foreign athletes): 2 men in court + 1 possible reserve M / Match days: Friday and Saturday
  - 2x2 Mixed: 1 man and 1 woman in court + 1 possible reserve F or M / Match days: Friday afternoon and Sunday
  - 3x3 Female: 3 women in court + 2 possible reserves F / Match days: Saturday and Sunday
  - 3x3 Male: 3 men in court + 2 possible reserves M / Match days: Saturday and Sunday
- 4x4 Mixed: 2 men and 2 women in court + 2 possible reserves F and/or M / Match days: Saturday and Sunday

#### **Jackpot Formula**

The 2024 edition of the AeQuilibrium Beach Volley Marathon® assigns a total prize money of up to euros 80,000.00 which with the "Jackpot Formula" will be doubled up to euros 160,000.00. In the registration phase, in fact, you can choose to have your team participate in the "Jackpot Formula" allowing it to compete for the highest prize pool (see section "[Prize Money](#)"). NB: the choice of the formula "Jackpot Formula" won't be accepted for any registration completed after the second expiry date.

#### **Team composition and athletes' list**

The team composition (roster) is decided by entering the names of the Athletes at registration. Any changes to the team composition (e.g.: replacing/removing/adding new athletes, variation in the required data and uploading of medical certificates) can always be made following these steps:

- after registration by sending an e-mail to the organising office with your request (bvm@radunisportivi.it);
- asking for the change at check-in.

An athlete can also be added during the qualifying matches with a formal request to the Director of the tournament who, after verifying the regularity of the request, will update the team composition, provided that the new athlete has not already played matches in the same game category. One athlete only can be added to the 2x2 F/M/Mixed categories and up to two athletes for the 3x3 F/M and 4x4 Mixed categories, without surpassing the limit of the possible reserves for the category. **Important note:** if the players in the court are not the same as the team composition (roster), the team will be immediately expelled from the tournament. There will be no sorting of teams for a second chance. The expelled team will have no refund rights or any awarding of prize money.

#### **2x2 F/2x2 M categories**

The 2x2 M/2x2 F matches will take place on Friday and Saturday. Only for the Special Edition (07th-08th June) teams must be composed only of foreign athletes. The formula will include a qualifying round (on Friday) and a final round (on Saturday) following a competition bracket with 32 teams with double elimination system: after the first game lost the team will move to the losing bracket and the team will be eliminated after the second match lost. The matches on Friday and Saturday are played in a single set to 21 points, with a 2 points lead with a 23 points limit; the finals matches only (1st -2nd and 3rd -4th places on Saturday) are played using the two out of three sets, to 21 points, with a 2 points lead with a 23 points limit and eventual 3rd set is played to 15 points with a, 2 points lead without a score limit. For the May

edition, to the final phase on Saturday will accede, for both game categories, the best 64 team of the qualification phase divided into two different competitions brackets: Gold bracket (1st-32nd) and Silver bracket (33rd-64th). For the June and September edition, to the final phase on Saturday will accede, for both game categories, the best 32 teams of the qualification phase: Gold (1st-32nd). **Note:** Teams that do not show up at the assigned court, or show up more than 5 minutes later than the scheduled time on the scoresheet, or are incomplete (without the minimum athletes' number based on the category) will be declared defeated by *forfait* with a score of 0-21. As an exception to the above mentioned rule, teams with one or more athletes playing a match in a different category at the same time of the beginning of the match, will be granted a 40-minutes delay from the scheduled time on the scoresheet. Beyond that time -40 minutes- the team will be asked by the Director of the Tournament to choose which match they will play in and, therefore, which match they will lose by default. Giving up a match will not entail an obligation of refund to the team by the organisation of the event. Teams playing several final round matches in different categories are required to let the Director of the Tournament know of any concurrent matches.

### **2×2 Mixed categories**

The 2×2 Mixed matches will take place on Friday and on Sunday. The playing formula is composed of a qualifying phase (on Friday from 1:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.) with pools of various teams (at least three matches guaranteed). A provisional ranking, based on the quotient of the scores of each team, will be established at the end of the qualifying round. In case of an equal score, the best places will be assigned according to the registration date and in the case of a further equal score lots will be drawn. The final round is played on Sunday with a bracket with 32 teams, following the double elimination system: after the first defeat the team will move to the losing bracket; after two defeats the team will be eliminated. For the May edition, the best 64 teams of the qualification phase will accede to the final phase on Sunday, divided into two different competitions brackets: Gold bracket (1st-32nd) and Silver bracket (33rd-64th). For the *Special Edition* and the September edition, the best 32 teams of the qualification phase (Gold bracket 1st-32nd) will enter the final phase on Sunday. All matches are played in a single set to 21 points, with a 2 points lead with a 23 points limit; the finals matches (1st-2nd place and 3rd-4th place) are also played in a single set to 21 points but in this case with a 2 points lead without a score limit. **Note:** Teams that do not show up at the assigned court, or show up more than 5 minutes later than the scheduled time on the scoresheet, or are incomplete (without the minimum athletes' number based on the category) will be declared defeated by *forfait* with a score of 0-21. As an exception to the above mentioned rule, teams with one or more athletes playing a match in a different category at the same time of the beginning of the match, will be granted a 40-minutes delay from the scheduled time on the scoresheet. Beyond that time -40 minutes- the team will be asked by the Director of the Tournament to choose which match they will play in and, therefore, which match they will lose by default. Giving up a match will not entail an obligation of refund to the team by the organisation of the event. Teams playing several final round matches in different categories are required to let the Director of the Tournament know of any concurrent matches.

### **3×3 M/F and 4×4 Mixed categories**

The matches of the 3×3 F, 3×3 M and 4×4 Mixed categories will take place on Saturday and Sunday and it will include a qualifying round (on Saturday) with a Round Robin system with pools of various teams (at least three matches guaranteed). A provisional ranking, based on the quotient of the scores of each team, will be established at the end of the qualifying round for each category. In case of an equal score, the best positions will be assigned according to the registration date and in the case of a further equal score lots will be drawn. The final round (on Sunday), based on the ranking above, will be played with single elimination system until the final matches in all the brackets. On Saturday and Sunday the matches are played in a single set to 21 points with a 2 points lead with a 23 points limit; the finals matches (1st-2nd place) are also played in a single set to 21 points with but in this case with a 2 points lead without a score limit. For the 3×3M - 3×3F and 4×4 Mixed categories, the best ranked 768 teams in the qualifying

round will access the final round, divided in four different brackets: Platinum Bracket (1st -192nd); Gold Bracket (193rd -384th); Silver Bracket (385th -576th); Bronze Bracket (577th -768th). In the event that the bracket of a final round has less than 32 teams, those teams will be included in the bracket that precedes it, for example: a Bronze Bracket with 30 registered teams will be included in the Silver Bracket. For the 3×3 M/F and the 4×4 Mixed categories the final match for the 3rd and 4th place will not be played: the two losing semi-finalist teams will both be placed 3rd and will be awarded an equal prize money. **Note:** Teams that do not show up at the assigned court, or show up more than 5 minutes later than the scheduled time on the scoresheet, or are incomplete (without the minimum athletes' number based on the category) will be declared defeated by *forfait* with a score of 0-21. As an exception to the above mentioned rule, teams with one or more athletes playing a match in a different category at the same time of the beginning of the match, will be granted a 40-minutes delay from the scheduled time on the scoresheet. Beyond that time -40 minutes- the team will be asked by the Director of the Tournament to choose which match they will play in and, therefore, which match they will lose by default. Giving up a match will not entail an obligation of refund to the team by the organisation of the event. Teams playing several final round matches in different categories are required to let the Director of the Tournament know of any concurrent matches.

### Schedule and matches program

The schedules may be subject to change.

- 2×2 F/2×2 M categories: Friday (qualifying round) from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.; Saturday (final round) from 8:30 a.m. and finals matches starting at 3:30 p.m.
- 2×2 Mixed category: Friday afternoon (qualifying round) from 1:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.; Sunday (final round) from 8:30 a.m., and finals matches starting 3:30 p.m.
- 3×3 F/3×3 M and 4×4 Mixed categories: Saturday (qualifying round) from 8:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.; Sunday (final round) from 8:30 a.m. and finals matches starting at 5:00 p.m.

### Refereeing

Participating athletes will act as referees according to the tournament schedule available in the dedicated section of the "BeachVolleyMarathon App". The finals matches will be refereed by official referees. All matches must be played in accordance with fair play values, athletes must accept the referee's decisions and be respectful to all the other participants and referees; otherwise, in the most serious cases, the Director of the Tournament can decide, at their own discretion, to exclude the participant from the tournament without any refund obligation.

### Filling in the scoresheets

The participants refereeing the matches will have to fill in scoresheets. The final score of the match must be clearly legible and must be signed by both teams in acceptance. In case of non-authentication, the final result of the match will still be considered valid and hence registered. **Note:** those scoresheets that do not allow a clear assignment of the result due to incomplete, false or illegible data will not be taken into consideration.

### Verifying the results of the qualifying rounds

For the 2×2 Mixed, 3×3 F/3×3 M and 4×4 Mixed categories, teams must check and verify the accuracy of the final results of their matches displayed in the dedicated section of the "BeachVolleyMarathon App". The results of the morning matches (8:30 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.) have to be checked before 2:00 p.m.; the results of the afternoon matches (1:30 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.) have to be checked before 7:00 p.m.- After those times no correction request of the results will be accepted.

### Matches won and lost by forfait

In the qualifying rounds of the 2×2 Mixed, 3×3 F/3×3 M and 4×4 Mixed categories, the results of the matches ended by forfait will be assigned to the losing team with a score of 0 points won and 21 points suffered,



this scoring will determine the quotient for the provisional ranking. However no points will be counted and assigned to teams winning the match by forfait.

#### **Final round: program and refereeing**

At the end of the qualifying rounds, the ranks for the 2×2 Mixed, 3×3 F/3×3 M and 4×4 Mixed categories will be available from 9:00 p.m. of the qualifying day, in the dedicated section of the BeachVolleyMarathonApp, where it will also be possible to verify the schedule of the matches and the refereeing assigned for the final round of all categories.

#### **Management of delays and concurrent matches**

Teams that do not show up at the assigned court, or show up more than 5 minutes later than the scheduled time on the scoresheet, or are incomplete (without the minimum athletes' number based on the category) will be declared defeated by *forfait* with a score of 0-21. As an exception to the above mentioned rule, teams with one or more athletes playing a match in a different category at the same time of the beginning of the match, will be granted a 40-minutes delay from the scheduled time on the scoresheet. Beyond that time -40 minutes- the team will be asked by the Director of the Tournament to choose which match they will play in and, therefore, which match they will lose by default. Giving up a match will not entail an obligation of refund to the team by the organisation of the event. **Note:** teams playing several final round matches in different categories are required to let the Director of the Tournament know of any concurrent matches.

#### **Tournament tank top**

For the finals and for all the other matches played at the central court, Athletes must wear the official event tank top (handed at check-in). **Note:** should any team not comply, they will not be awarded any prize money.

#### **Bad weather conditions and other external event**

The event will take place in any weather condition. In case of particularly adverse weather conditions or circumstance (other external events) The Tournament Director may decide, at his absolute discretion, to suspend one or more matches and choose to resume them when external conditions allow it. With the resumption of the match, the score set at the time of suspension will be maintained. The Tournament Director, at his absolute discretion, may modify the playing formula: decide that matches shall be played at 15 points instead of 21 and/or decide that matches, even during the qualifying phase, shall be knockout and/or foreseen a reduction in the number of matches of the round and/or any other necessary modification, including the eventual permanent suspension of the matches.

#### **For the 2×2 F/M categories**

- In the case of a permanent suspension of the qualifying round matches, the placements of the teams still in the game, that have not been assigned yet, will be decided according to the registration date or, in case of a tie, by drawing lots. In the case of not being able to play any qualifying round matches, the ranking will be decided according to the registration date or, in case of a tie, by drawing lots.
- In the case of a permanent suspension of the finals round matches, for each related bracket, the prize money, except for the part that may have already been awarded, will be equally divided among the remaining teams, still in the game at the time of the suspension, except when the amount of the award to be assigned to each team will be less than 100.00 euros per team.

#### **For the 2×2 Mixed categories**

- In the case of a permanent suspension of the qualifying round matches, the provisional rank will be established according to the results of each team at the time of the suspension; a default score, based on the average score (quotient points) of all the matches so far played, will be assigned to those teams that will not have played any games. In case of an equal score, places will be assigned according to the registration date and in the case of a further equal score lots will be drawn. In the case of not being able to play any qualifying round matches, the ranking will be decided according

to the registration date or, in case of a tie, by drawing lots. The prize on offer for the category will be equally divided between those on the score board and a percentage equal to that applied for the different placings.

- In the case of a permanent suspension of the finals round matches, for each related bracket, the prize money, except for the part that may have already been awarded, will be equally divided among the remaining teams, still in the game at the time of the suspension, except when the amount of the award to be assigned to each team will be less than 100.00 euros per team.

#### **For the 3×3 and the 4×4 categories**

- In the case of a permanent suspension of the qualifying round matches, the provisional ranks will be established according to the results of each team at the time of the suspension; a default score, based on the average score (quotient points) of all the matches so far played in their category, will be assigned to those teams that will not have played any games. In case of an equal score, places will be assigned according to the registration date and in the case of a further equal score lots will be drawn. In the case of a permanent suspension of the qualifying round matches, the prize money for each category will be equally divided among the brackets, according to the percentages applied to the different positions in the ranks. The prize on offer for the category will be equally divided between those on the score board and a percentage equal to that applied for the different placings.
- In the case of a permanent suspension of the finals round matches, for each related scoreboard, the prize money, except for the part that may have already been awarded, will be equally divided among the remaining teams, still in the game at the time of the suspension, except when the amount of the award to be assigned to each team will be less than 100.00 euros per team.

#### **Competition schedule**

Competition schedules can be checked, the week previous to the beginning of the event, in the free app "BeachVolleyMarathonApp". In the app you will also be able to check and verify the correct registration of your team.

#### **Rankings**

The provisional rankings of the qualifying rounds will be available on the "BeachVolleyMarathonApp" after the matches once the scores have been calculated (after 9 pm). The final rankings will be available in the days after the tournament. In the free "BeachVolleyMarathonApp", among other things, you will be able to look for your team, its score, its placement, the matches played and to be played, the matches to be refereed, the number of the assigned court, etc.-

#### **Prize Money**

The September 2024 AeQuilibrium Beach Volley Marathon® edition will award a prize money up to euros 80.000,00 that will be doubled up to euros 160.000,00 with the 'Jackpot Formula'. When registering, you can choose to have your team participate in the "Jackpot Formula", allowing it to compete for the highest prize money. **Attention:** the choice of the formula "Jackpot Formula" won't be accepted for any registration completed after the second expiry date. The amounts are intended as pre-tax (presently amounting to 20% according to article 30, Presidential Decree 600/ 1973) and will be paid out at the end of the tournament, after filling out a receipt. We remind you that, In the case of a permanent suspension of the finals round matches, for each related scoreboard, the prize money, except for the part that may have already been awarded, will be equally divided among the remaining teams, still in the game at the time of the suspension, except when the amount of the award to be assigned to each team will be less than 100.00 euros per team. In this case no prize money will be assigned. During the awards ceremony, all the teams on the podium (1st, 2nd and 3rd place), will receive gadgets and other items from the sponsors, on top of the prize money. The awarding of the medals is for the teams on the podium (1st, 2nd and 3rd place) of the 2×2 F/M/Mixed categories, 3×3 M/F categories and for 4×4 Mixed categories (Platinum score board). The prize must be collected by a team member with their personal ID and a tax code number within one hour of the end of the match for which the prize money is to be awarded: with

the exception of the teams called to the podium who should collect their prize only after having taken part in the prize given ceremony. Any prize money not collected within an hour after the prize given ceremony, will be donated to the non-profit association: ONLUS SOS HANDICAP BAMBINI INVISIBILI. The same will happen to those teams who don't present themselves at the ceremony.

**Important note:** the amounts up for grabs will be assigned with an overall participation of at least 3000 teams in the May edition, at least 700 teams in the June Special Edition and at least 700 teams in the September edition. In the event that the total number of registered teams will be lower than the above mentioned numbers, the amounts of the prize money will be reduced proportionally. We remind you that should a score board of a final round have a number of teams lower than 32, these will be inserted in the preceding score board. For example: a Bronze score board with 30 registered teams will be included in the Silver score board. In this case, the prize money of the Bronze score board, will not be added to the prize money of the Silver score board.

### Check-in

Upon arrival in Bibione, the person in charge of the contract (with their personal ID) must check-in for the event. They must pay for any outstanding participation, accommodation and service fees. The same person will then be able to collect the personal passes, the tank tops for the Athletes and the vouchers for any additional purchases made (extras on request). At check-in the team compositions and the validity of the medical certificates will also be checked. **Note:** the check-in can also be made by a substitute of the person in charge of the contract, provided that they have a personal ID and the sales contract that will act as a proxy. The check-in will take place in Bibione in a dedicated area, close to the playing area, access from via Ariete and from via delle Colonie, 4. Check-in times are scheduled as follows: Thursday from 3.00 p.m. to 9.00 p.m. | Friday from 7.45 am to 9.00 p.m. | Saturday from 7.45 a.m. to 12.00 p.m.-

### Stays in agreement information

For all those using affiliated accommodation in residences, tourist villages (resorts), aparthotels and hostels, accommodation will be available starting from 4:30 p.m. on arrival day and must be left by 10:00 a.m. on departure day, unless otherwise stated in the contract (or otherwise agreed with the management of the accommodation). When receiving the keys to the accommodation a deposit (from euros 100.00) is required and will be returned on departure day once the accommodation has been checked. For those staying in affiliated hotels the rooms will be made available from 12:00 p.m. (unless otherwise agreed with the management of the hotel for an earlier access) and must be left by 10:00 a.m. on departure day (unless otherwise agreed with the hotel). All those using affiliated accommodation will be required to pay a tourist tax on arrival day, in cash, to the management of the accommodation; the amount of the tax will be communicated to the person in charge of the contact in the week before the sport event.

For arrivals after accommodation rental agency closing time and after 9:00 p.m. (tournament check-in closing time) it's anyway possible to get access to the affiliated accommodation booked, using the booking voucher (sent to you in the days before the starting of the event), and show up to the tournament check-in the following day. The organising office will send an email to the person in charge of the contract the week before the tournament with all the information about the "Attendance Register" to fill before the arrival, about where to collect the keys of the accommodation booked and additional information about the payment of the city tax (to pay on arrival by cash); information and instructions on how to get the keys will also be provided for any arrivals after the agency and check-in closing time.

- Guests staying in a residence or apartment will be able to collect an envelope, containing the accommodation's keys and the map to reach it, at the check-in area starting from one hour after the agency closing time and till 9:00 p.m.; afterwards, keys will be available at the night distribution point, indicated in the information mail, from 10:30 p.m. to 00:00 a.m.- **Note:** upon departure, the keys will have to be delivered to the agency.
- Guests staying in aparthotels, tourist villages (resorts) and residences with a reception (this information will be available at registration) will be able to collect the keys from the reception of the assigned accommodation. Please advise the management of your late arrival.

- Guests staying in hotels are advised to choose 4-star accommodation that guarantees the presence of a night porter. In any case, please, remember to inform the hotel of your late arrival.
- Guests staying in hostels must collect the keys at the hostel before 10:00 p.m. on arrival day.

### **Personal pass**

At check-in, the person in charge of the contract (or a delegate) in possession of the sales of contract and identity card (not written delegation is required), will be handed the personal passes (coloured bracelets) that each participant will be required to wear on their wrist or ankle for the whole duration of the event. In case of damage, the personal pass will be changed with a new one, upon returning the old one, at the check-in area. For those who registered as "Athletes" the personal pass allows the participation in the tournament; for those who registered as "Non-Athlete" it allows the use of a wide number of reserved Beach Volley courts and the participation - for the May edition only and subject to availability - to the open Beach Sitting ParaVolley tournament. The personal pass, along with the QR code generated by the "Sportfelix" app, in addition to participation in the tournament and access to the evening parties on the beach, will allow discounts on renting beach umbrellas and beach loungers; discounts in pizzerias and other affiliated restaurants/pubs/bars. **Important note:** teams playing a match, with one or more athletes without the personal pass, will be immediately expelled from the tournament without any refund obligation; furthermore, the disqualified team will not be awarded any prize money.

### **Night Beach Parties**

The Beach Parties do not require the purchase of an entrance ticket as they are reserved exclusively to the participants of age registered to the sports event as 'Athletes' or 'Non-Athletes'. Drinks will be served within the area from 7:30 p.m. to 10 p.m. The last call for drinks is 10 p.m. The police, assisted by a private security service, will be present at all times to make sure that everyone follows the rules and regulations to protect and respect all the participants. The introduction of backpacks, bags or any other object considered dangerous, including any type of bottle and/or can, is forbidden. Only belt bags and small shoulder bags will be allowed. The objects that cannot be introduced in the area will be placed in unguarded storage at the entrance of the "party area". **Important note:** it is highly recommended not to enter the party area with valuables. In case of particularly adverse weather conditions, the Organiser can decide, at their own discretion, to suspend the night beach parties without any refund obligation.

### **Private parties forbidden**

Participants are not allowed to organise parties or any other kind of gathering with loud music inside the assigned accommodation. Therefore, it is highly recommended to avoid any police intervention and the resulting fines. **Important note:** as stated in the [General Rules](#), being turned away from your accommodation, due to undesired behaviour, will result in the automatic exclusion from the Tournament without any refund from the organisation.

### **Stay in agreement**

At registration a wide range of affiliated accommodation is offered for a minimum of a 2-night stay: residences, apartments, mobile homes, aparthotels, hotels and hostels. Affiliated accommodation is subject to availability. Except for hotels and some aparthotels, the stay does not include daily tidying and cleaning of the accommodation; towels and sheets are not provided but can be requested at booking by paying an extra. Usually, accommodations are available starting from early afternoon of the arrival day and must be vacated by 10:00 a.m. on the departure day but, according to availability, it could be possible to access them already in the morning and leave them in the afternoon (late check-out). The organizing office can modify the accommodation details according to availability, after having informed the person in charge of the contract. To those taking advantage of affiliated accommodation, in the days preceding the event, the organizing office will send an e-mail, a week before the beginning of the sport event, to the contract's holder with all the necessary information about the affiliated accommodation and how to retrieve the keys.

## Where to eat

During the Sport Event, at the sports area there will be a food area with several kiosks and food trucks for the participants; in any case, in Bibione there are a lot of pizzerias, restaurants and bars with take-away food for every need.

## Accommodation in apartments, residences and tourist villages

Affiliated accommodation in apartments, residences or mobile homes (inside tourist villages or resort) is available for stays of a minimum of two nights and it is offered as follows: "Roulette option" and "Special option". "Roulette option" has a cheaper price since the accommodation is assigned randomly and does not allow the Participant to choose the facility. "Special option" allows the participant to choose the desired accommodation, in this case, the price may vary depending on the chosen accommodation. During the registration, you can see and select the accommodation type from the "Accommodation" section. Stay does not include daily tidying and cleaning of the accommodation; bed linen and towels for some accommodations are included in the price while for others they can be optionally requested at the time of booking with an additional cost.

**Accommodation type.** Indicatively, below the description of some types of accommodation; during registration, at the time of booking, the exact description will be available for each type selected.

- Residence: two-room apartment 4/5 beds: bathroom, living room with kitchenette and double sofa bed (French sized bed), plus double bed bedroom and possibility of a third bed in the 5-bed accommodation option.
- Residence: three-room apartment 6/7 beds: bathroom, living room with kitchenette and double sofa bed (French sized bed), twin bedroom and double bed bedroom plus possibility of a third bed in the double bedroom in the 7-bed accommodation option.
- Residence: Four-room apartment 7/8 beds: usually two bathrooms, living room with kitchenette and double sofa bed (French sized bed), three bedrooms for two people of which at least one has a double bed.

## Check-in

Access to the housing units will be possible from 4.30 p.m. on arrival day, unless early arrival has been agreed on with the management of the accommodation facility. Unless otherwise agreed, you will be able to access your accommodation before checking in for the event by showing, at the reception of the accommodation facility, the booking voucher of your stay which the organising office will have sent to the person in charge of the contract in the days preceding the starting date of the event. Upon arrival, when you receive the keys, a security deposit of 100.00 euros will be withheld. It will be returned on departure day after the rooms have been checked by the management of the accommodation.

## Check-out

The keys must be given back to the management of the accommodation by 10.00 a.m. on departure day, (or as stated in the contract if you have required a late check-out) otherwise the security deposit will not be returned. The final cleaning of the unit can be requested on arrival from the management of the accommodation facility at a price starting from 50.00 euros per unit. The accommodation must be left in order, tidied and cleaned. The rubbish must have been taken out, the fridge must have been emptied and, if defrosted, the door must be left open. Pans and dishes must have been washed and stowed away and the cooking corner must have been cleaned even when the final cleaning service has been purchased. Considering the cleaning of the accommodation is mandatory on departure, under penalty of loss of the deposit, it is strongly recommended to agree with the manager of the accommodation facility the joint control of the accommodation at the time of departure.

**Evening arrivals.** For arrivals **after 9:00 p.m.**, it's possible to get access to the affiliated accommodation booked and show up to the tournament check-in the following day. It will be possible to collect the keys of the accommodation and the map to reach it at the check-in area, from 10.30 pm to midnight. Guests staying in residences with a reception (this information will be available at registration) will be able to

collect the keys from the reception of the assigned accommodation. Please remember to communicate the late arrival to the management of the accommodation.

**Info.** The accommodations (in residences and resort) are equipped with a kitchenette, dishes and cooking utensils (except for tablecloths and kitchen towels), pillows and blankets, except for bed linen and towels that could be included or not in the package and, in this case, which can be requested when booking. There are not any house cleaning products, any toiletries (nor complimentary toiletries) or any toilet paper. Each accommodation has a parking place.

### **Regulation**

**a)** It is not possible to accommodate more people than the beds available in the unit. **b)** It is recommended to bring with you toilet paper, hygiene kits and all other toiletries, house cleaning products, tablecloths, kitchen towels and bathroom towels and bed linen. If you have requested bed linen and towels: in some cases the management will hand them to you together with the keys, in other cases the management will leave them in the rented unit. On departure day the towels and bed linen must be left folded on the bed or, if required, handed to the management. We remind you that for each missing towel or bedlinen 10.00 euros will be withheld from the deposit. **c)** Access to the units will be possible after 4.30 p.m. on arrival day, unless early arrival has been agreed on with the management of the accommodation facility. The keys must be handed back to the management of the rented accommodation by 10.00 a.m. on departure day (or as stated in the contract if late check-out has been agreed on), otherwise the security deposit will not be returned. **d)** Before accessing the accommodation it will be necessary to fill in the "Guest Register" and to pay cash the tourist tax to the management of the accommodation. The week before the starting date of the event the organising office will send an email to the person in charge of the contract with information on how to register guests (Guest register). They will also be given detailed instructions on how to collect the keys of the accommodation, on the payment of the tourist tax and any other useful information about the accommodation. **e)** When receiving the keys to the accommodation a deposit (100.00 euros per unit) is required and will be returned on departure day once the accommodation has been checked by the management of the accommodation facility - a credit card might be required as warranty. We recommend that you agree on checking the unit together with the management of the accommodation facility on departure day. **f)** Any kind of damage noticed by the tenants upon arrival or caused during their stay, must be reported immediately to the management of the accommodation and to the organising office. **g)** For any inconvenience, empty gas cylinder, lack of electricity, water leakage, loss of keys, etc., you must directly contact the management of the accommodation. In case the unit is managed by a lessor agency you will have their phone numbers on the envelopes that contain the keys handed to you on arrival day. **h)** Cleaning the rented units is compulsory on departure day, otherwise the security deposit will not be returned. The final cleaning of the unit can be requested, and paid for, directly from the management at a price starting from 50.00 euros per unit. Therefore, on departure day, the accommodation must be left in order, tidied and cleaned. The rubbish must have been taken out, the fridge must have been emptied and, if defrosted, the door must be left open. Pans and dishes must have been washed and stowed away and the cooking corner must have been cleaned. Note: the final cleaning service of the unit does not include taking out the rubbish and cleaning the kitchen corner which will always be the responsibility of the tenants. Attention: lessor agencies close their offices at 6.30 p.m. After that time, it will not be possible to request any type of intervention. Therefore, it is recommended to access the allocated accommodation by 6.00 p.m. to check the correct functioning of the supply systems (electricity, water, gas). The organising office will not be able to provide any assistance to the participants that will check-in after 6.00 p.m. We would like to remind you that using the hair dryer together with other electrical appliances (e.g. the water boiler) can cause exceeding the available power and the safety switch will disconnect the electricity: the light will turn off automatically and you will be left in the dark!

### **Accommodation in aparthotel**

Affiliated accommodation in aparthotel is offered with a minimum stay of two nights in B&B (Bed and

breakfast) and combine the comfort of a hotel stay to the functionality of an apartment.

**Accommodation type.** Lodging (one-two-three room) from 2 to 6 beds, with kitchenette, fridge and dishes and cooking utensils, bed linens and towels, Bed&Breakfast.

**Check-in.** Access to the units is from 4.30 p.m. on arrival day, unless early check-in has been agreed on with the management of the accommodation. Unless otherwise agreed, you will be able to access your accommodation before checking in for the event by showing, at the reception of the accommodation facility, the booking voucher of your stay which the organising office will have sent to the person in charge of the contract in the days preceding the starting date of the event. Upon arrival, when you receive the keys, a security deposit of 100.00 euros will be withheld. It will be returned on departure day after the rooms have been checked by the management of the accommodation.

**Check-out.** The keys must be returned to the reception by 10.00 a.m. on departure day, (unless otherwise agreed) or the security deposit will not be returned. The accommodation must be left in order, tidied and cleaned. The rubbish must have been taken out, the fridge must have been emptied and, if defrosted, the door must be left open. Pans and dishes must have been washed and stowed away and the cooking corner must have been cleaned. The final cleaning of the unit can be requested on arrival from the management of the accommodation facility at a price starting from 50.00 euros per unit. This service does not include rubbish takeout and kitchen cleaning, which are always a Guest's responsibility.

**Evening arrivals.** For arrivals after 9:00 p.m, it's possible to get access to the affiliated accommodation booked and show up to the tournament check-in the following day. Keys have to be collected directly at the reception on the facility. For arrival after 9:00 p.m., please remember to communicate the late arrival to the management of the accommodation.

**Info.** The accommodations are equipped with a kitchenette, dishes and cooking utensils (except for tablecloths and kitchen towels), pillows and blankets, bedlinen and towels, buffet breakfast and final cleaning are included in the package. Each accommodation has a parking place.

#### **Stay in agreement: Hotel**

Affiliated accommodation in hotels is offered with a minimum stay of two nights in B&B (bed and breakfast). HB (half board) or FB (full boards) are optional services and are not available in all of the affiliated hotels. Note: it will not be possible to book one room for guests with different length of stay.

**Check-in.** Access to the rooms is from 12.00 a.m. on arrival day, unless early arrival has been agreed on with the management of the accommodation facility. Unless otherwise agreed, you will be able to access your room before checking in for the event by showing, at the reception of the accommodation facility, the booking voucher of your stay, that the organising office (or the Associazione Bibionese Albergatori – the hotel association of Bibione) will have sent to the person in charge of the contract in the days preceding the starting date of the event.

**Check-out.** The room keys must be returned to the reception of the hotel by 10.00 a.m. on departure day. A late check-out needs to be agreed on, by the guest, at the reception of the hotel.

**Evening arrivals after 9 pm.** Guests staying in hotels are advised to choose 4-star accommodation that guarantees the presence of a night porter. In any case, please, remember to inform the hotel of the late arrival.

**Info.** Each room is ensuite and has pillows, blankets, bedlinen and towels. According to the category of the hotel there will be: air conditioning, TV, minibar, hair dryer and complimentary toiletries. Breakfast and daily cleaning are included. In some hotels HB and FB are available upon request. Each room has a parking space.

#### **Stay in agreement: Hostels**

Affiliated accommodation in hostels is offered with a minimum stay of two nights in OB (only bed without breakfast). Keys must be taken before 10 pm on the day of arrival; when receiving the keys to the room a deposit of 50.00 euros per room is required and it will be returned on departure day once the

accommodation has been checked by the management. Rooms must be left by 10 a.m. on departure day, tidied and cleaned and the rubbish must have been taken out, under penalty of losing the deposit. It will not be possible to book one room for guests with different length of stay.

**Rooms.** Room with private or shared bathroom in OB (only bed).

**Check-in.** Access to the rooms is from 12.00 a.m. on arrival day, unless early arrival has been agreed on with the management of the accommodation facility. Keys must be collected strictly before 10.00 p.m. on arrival day from the reception of the facility. When receiving the keys to the room a deposit (50.00 euros per room) is required and will be returned on departure day once the accommodation has been checked. Unless otherwise agreed, you will be able to access your room before checking in for the event by showing, at the reception of the accommodation facility, the booking voucher of your stay, that the organising office will have sent to the person in charge of the contract in the days preceding the starting date of the event.

**Check-out.** Rooms must be left by 10.00 a.m. on departure day, tidied and cleaned and the rubbish must have been taken out, under penalty of losing the deposit.

**Evening arrivals after 9 pm.** The collection of the keys must be done strictly by 10:00 p.m. on the day of arrival.

**Info.** Rooms from 2 to 6 beds are ensuite. There are pillows and blankets, but there is neither bed linen or towels that can be requested at booking by paying extra. In the houses there are no cleaning products, nor personal hygiene products (courtesy set) and toilet paper. Each room has a parking space.

### **Stay In agreement: Camping**

Stay in agreement in Camping is offered with a minimum of two nights stay.

**Check -in.** Entrance to the pitch is possible from 11 am on arrival day, unless early arrival has been agreed on with the management of the accommodation facility. Unless otherwise agreed, you will be able to access your pitch before checking in for the event by showing, at the reception of the accommodation facility, the booking voucher of your stay, that the organising office will have sent to the person in charge of the contract in the days preceding the starting date of the event.

**Check-out.** Pitch has to be left before 6.30 pm on departure day.

**Evening arrivals after 9 pm.** Tents must be set before 10.30 pm on arrival day; after this time, tents set up are foreseen in a specific camping area before midnight, upon agreement with the accommodation facility. Entrance to the camping with campers and/or mobile homes has to be done before 11 pm on arrival day, after this time a night stopover is foreseen in a dedicated parking lot; you will access the pitch on the following morning.

**Parking lot.** Legislative decree D.C. PREV. 11002 of 12/09/2014, point B.2.3 title II, establishes that inside the camping, vehicles must keep one metre distance from the tents. Therefore, vehicle access in the parking area will be planned by the Direction of the Village when arriving, assuring a parking lot per pitch.
